Meet Conditions:

1. Age as at day of the meet, 29 September 2019.
2. This meet will be conducted under SNZ rules and the local conditions listed. No time trials permitted.
3. **Please note that the ASA Technical Swim Suits Restriction Policy applies:** Swimmers aged 12 years and under are not permitted to compete in Technical Swim Suits at ASA inter-club meets..
 - This policy applies to all 12/U ASA swimmers and visitors competing at ALL ASA Meets with the exception of ASA Age Groups and ASA Opens.
 - Swimmers who are unsure if their suit complies are encouraged to take it to the Technical Director for clearance BEFORE the start of the meet / session.
 - Team Managers/ coaches are encouraged to check that their swimmers suits comply BEFORE the start of the meet/session.
4. Entries **\$9.50 per individual event**. Late entries (**\$15.00 per event**) will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane. No refunds on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
5. Swimmers are required to meet the qualifying standard of at least one ASA Level 2 event. Swimmers with a Level 1 time are not permitted to enter.
6. All events will be timed finals, with results declared for males and females in the following age groups: 11/under, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & over.
7. This is a self-marshalling meet. Over the top starts and the ONE START rule will apply. Reseeding or combining of heats will be at the Referee's discretion.
8. All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
9. Poolside Officials: ASA will endeavour to obtain the necessary number of officials but the number on poolside may be more or less than the requirement set out in SNZ rules.
10. Clubs to supply: 1 Official per 4 swimmers per session to a max of 6 unless requested for more before the meet. Clubs to email names of officials **by Monday 23 September 2019** to Hiroko Shibuya (mtedenentries@gmail.com)
11. Meet Controller: **Darryl Follows** (imesecretary@gmail.com)

Health and safety is everyone's responsibility.

- 1. Prior to approving swimmers' entries, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient understanding, skill, and experience to conduct themselves in a manner that assures their safety and the safety of others.*
- 2. All swimmers must show an ASA membership card or otherwise be able to demonstrate they have an entry in the competition.*
- 3. Coaches must sign in and wear an ASCAT identification at all times.*
- 4. Team Managers must sign in and will be issued with an identification card.*
- 5. Officials and timekeepers must sign in and either be wearing an ASA Technical Officials shirt or be issued with an identification card.*
- 6. All spectators be seated upstairs. No spectators are permitted on pool deck at any time.*
- 7. No long lens photography unless approval has been expressly given by the Mt Eden Swimming Club.*
