MEET CONDITIONS:

- Age as at day of meet, 24 November 2019.
- Entries \$9.00 per event. Late entries \$16.00 per event, will be accepted at the discretion of the organiser, only if there is a spare lane. Heats will not be reseeded.
- Entries to be submitted via SNZ database. **Entries close at Wednesday 13th November 2019.**
- No refund on scratching, unless a medical certificate is sighted no later than 48 hours from the end of the meet.
- SNZ Rules and local rules apply.
- Swimmers must have achieved a level 1 time in at least one event to enter this meet.
- No time trials permitted.
- Over the top starts and the One Start Rule will apply.
- Clubs to provide: 1 official per 4 swimmers, per session. Clubs to email names of officials by Monday 18th November 2019 to Henriette Smeets (unitedmeetentries@gmail.com)
- This is a self-marshalling meet.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Regulations.
- Poolside Officials: ASA will endeavour to obtain the necessary number of officials but the number on poolside may be more or less than the requirement set out in the SNZ rules.
- **12/U Tech Suit Restriction** – PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ASA TECH SUIT RESTRICTION POLICY APPLIES TO ALL 12/U SWIMMERS. If in doubt get your Team Manager to check with the Technical Director BEFORE the start of the session.
- Only swimmers, officials, coaches and authorised team managers to be on pool deck.

Health and safety.

- Prior to approving swimmers' entries, coaches must ensure participants have sufficient understanding, skill, and experience to conduct themselves in a manner that assures their safety and the safety of others.
- All persons on pool deck (swimmers, coaches, managers, officials/volunteers) must enter through the back door.
- All swimmers must show an ASA membership card. Visiting swimmers will be issued with a temporary identification.
- Coaches must sign in and wear an ASCAT identification at all times.
- Team Managers must sign in and will be issued with an identification card.
- Officials and timekeepers must sign in and either be wearing an ASA Technical Officials shirt or be issued with an identification card.
- All spectators must enter through the West Wave main entrance and be seated upstairs. No spectators are permitted on pool deck at any time.
- No long lens photography unless approval has been expressly given by the United Swimming Club.
