In addition to the Swimming NZ code of conduct for swimmers, United has its own code of conduct for its swimmers:

1. Contribute to a fun and enjoyable environment
2. Behave with care, courtesy and consideration at all times
3. Be prepared – arrive on time and with the right equipment
4. Work hard and let others work hard too
5. Respect and take pride in your club
6. Show respect and care for the property of others, including the pool and gym facilities and surrounding grounds
7. Listen and follow instructions and pay others respect including all club coaches, managers, officials and administrators
8. Be polite to everyone; show team spirit and good sportsmanship at ALL times
9. Support your club and team mates whenever and wherever possible
10. Understand and follow the club uniform protocols
11. Any form of bullying will not be tolerated.
12. Ensure you understand and apply the club's Social Media Policy
13. Swimmers must not use tobacco products or illegal drugs or substances banned by Swimming NZ or FINA and all participants and agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules
14. Understand and follow the training, lane swimming, competition meet and uniform protocols set out below
