

Uniform Protocols

When we represent United it is important that we do so in accordance with our standards and values. This includes both how we conduct ourselves and how we wear the United uniform when we are travelling as a team and when we are representing our club at swim meets

Our uniform protocols are intended to reflect the “United” team spirit and the high performance and professional attitude of our club. These protocols apply to all team travel and all competitive swim meets and are required to be followed by all members

1. Only United approved uniform is to be worn (no “mix and matching”)
2. In the event that you do not have a United approved item, then the only permitted alternative is the same item in plain black
3. All items should be in a tidy, clean, and presentable state

The requirements for the different situations are as follows:

Team Travel

- United standard black t-shirt (short or long sleeve)
- United black shorts or United tracksuit pants
- United black hoodie or United long sleeve rugby jersey

National and Regional Meets

- United black swim cap or United named cap
- United black shorts or United tracksuit pants
- United standard black t-shirt (short or long sleeve) or United black singlet or commemorative event gear
- If applicable, United commemorative item for the specific event and current year
- United black hoodie or United long sleeve rugby jersey
- United pool coat (optional)

Other Meets (e.g., Level 1,2,3 meets):

- The same as for “National and Regional Meets” with the additional item:
- United commemorative event items from national meets from the current year provided they are in a tidy, clean, and presentable state

Medal Podium

- United black shorts or United tracksuit pants or black skins (females)
- United standard black t-shirt (short or long sleeve)
- If applicable, United commemorative item for the specific event and current year
- United black hoodie or United long sleeve rugby jersey
- **Items not to be worn on the podium:** non United hoodie, pool coat, beanie, towel, or previous years’ commemorative event items
